





### Project's results

The LeaderAl project consortium adopts an approach which addresses the need for effective Higher Education (HE) digital learning that responds to students' needs, strengths, and skills, through the proper exploitation of Al-based tools and data-driven technologies.











3. The Dissemination Workshops will inform decision makers/NGOs and officers from relevant Ministries, experts in the field of education about the project achievements and ways to valorize them.

Interactive eLearning platform and digital resources will equip HE staff with a collection of hands-on digital teaching and learning material they can access anytime-anywhere; will demonstrate the usage of Al-based and analytics tools for personalised teaching and learning purposes; will build HE staff's pedagogical and digital competences in personalising their courses through selected Al-based and analytics tools; and will allow HE staff to participate in a virtual community for knowledge sharing.

#### Partners first steps and meetings

The consortium met online few times to start working on the materials and ideas of the project.

Then, on 10<sup>th</sup> of March 2023, representatives from partners institutions met in Rhodes at the University of Aegean, to analyse the achieved results so far and plan for the next activities.

The implementation of research activities related to the LeaderAl Toolkit development went well in all countries - the literature review is finalised and the processing of the administered questionnaires' results is almost ready! All partners will elaborate their research report based on these achievements!
