


### **Project's results**

#### **OUR TOOLKIT IS READY!**

The Toolkit produced by LeaderAl project consortium has been developed and has successfully passed the testing face! Now, it follows to be translated in partners languages.

## Partners activities and meetings

Partners have been holding different online meetings in May and September 2023 to keep up with the work.



Once that all the Toolkit's components have been finalized and aggregated into one document – results from the literature review, from the Focus Groups' implementation and from questionnaires' administration, the Toolkit entered in the testing face, when a project-dedicated expert body composed of over 50 stakeholders from Cyprus, Greece, Estonia, Portugal and Romania evaluated the Toolkit and provided us with valuable feedback.

Our consortium also started developing Pedagogical Scenarios for using Artificial Intelligence (AI), to create - based on these scenarios - a training programme for Higher Education teaching staff to learn them how to personalise their instruction through open source/freeware Al-based and data visualisation tools that do not require highly specialised computer skills, such as programming.

## Next steps

Our next steps for the following months will be to translate the Toolkit in partner languages and provide free access to it via the LeaderAl eLearning platform, finalise the Pedagogical Scenarios and create the training programme.

Furthermore, we will continue disseminating our achievements and results, and we will approach new project phases, namely preparing and conducting the train-the-trainer workshops virtually and organise the national pilot sessions of the Scenario-based Training Programme.
